





# **Assistant Pastor's Corner**

Dear St. Mary/Assumption Parishioners,

To some extent, the person we are today is in part due to our upbringing. There certainly is a reality that we are a product, in a sense, of the formation we received while growing up. My father was somewhat particular about various things that really have stuck with me. I suppose you could say that they were like unwritten rules to not violate. Here are a few of them: 1. Do not drive over snow on the driveway. Scoop a path first. Driving over it will only cause it to turn into ice and then it will be around twice as long. 2. In the winter you need to always keep your gas tank above half full. 3. In the winter you need take the opportunity to wash your vehicle on nice days to get the road salt off your vehicle, especially the undercarriage of your vehicle, to avoid corrosion and rust damage.

These are just a few of dad's unwritten rules that still seem to influence my life to an extent. This is why the other day I found myself at the car wash and trying to give the undercarriage a good rinse to combat all the grime from our snowy roads. I got thinking about how often some people, including myself, keep their vehicles looking clean. I wonder why they find it to be a necessary part of their life. Perhaps it is because they don't like things to be dirty, they always want things to be their best, or perhaps it is because they, too, were formed to take care of their vehicle to combat the winter road salt.

Thinking about this, I thought, wouldn't it be awesome if we had a similar outlook to cleaning our souls and going to confession. I don't know about you, but I try to wash my vehicle regularly. I would say that I probably on average wash my vehicle once a month. Perhaps a good litmus test for how often we should go to confession is as often as you wash your car. As much as I love a clean looking vehicle, how much more important is it too keep our soul clean? And parents, perhaps one of the unwritten rules you can pass on to your children will be to take the opportunity and go to confession on regular basis. It is in this Sacrament that God takes away the corrosive grime we accumulate. Praise God for his care for our souls! This winter let's not just keep our vehicles clean, but also allow God to keep our souls clean in the merciful Sacrament of Confession.
