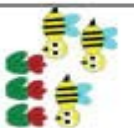

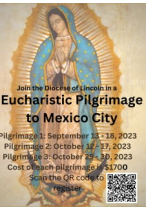

Dear Parishioners,
By now you may know I enjoy breakfast. I love that the Resurrected Jesus also enjoyed eating breakfast with his disciples on the lake shore. We are combining breakfast with the Charity and Stewardship Appeal (CSA) in hopes of attracting more pledges this first weekend, in the gym, Sunday, April 30, after the 8 and 10 a.m. Masses. Saturday, we will have cookies available in the gym. Pledge cards will be out. I will show a short video at Masses on the CSA, make an appeal and encourage you all to take the time to walk across the parking lot to make your pledge. Please help us get off to a record-breaking start. We have about a dozen people bringing breakfast foods, so there should be plenty. As you know, we need to reach our goal of \$52,370 for St. Mary’s and \$4,350 for Assumption. Because we support a K-12 school, we receive 80% of this goal back to the parishes up to the goal and 100% over the goal. I think that all the causes that CSA supports are important. We need a strong response because in 2022 we collected about 50% of our budgeted number. We will keep you posted on our progress .

Please also take a gander at our Didier room when making your pledge. Ray Kobza, Tom Samek, Tom Polacek, Cork DeWispelare and others have (almost) completed the installation of the cabinets on the east end. Judy and Ken Polacek cleaned it up and so we can enjoy using it again. Thanks also to Cork for helping Fr. Schukei and I assemble the cabinets in the SW corner of the Narthex.

I get a lot of satisfaction from seeing our lawn look so green. I want to thank Nick Romshek for donating the application and fertilizer for St. Mary’s. I enjoyed cleaning up our backyard and being able to blow the walkways clean this week with my newly purchased electric blower bought at Harvest Festival.

We had very good Stewardship and Finance Committee meetings this past week. I appreciate the time and talents of these parishioners. I am slowly learning more about the history and background of our parish and what our needs are.

We pray for the repose of the soul of Betty Kozisek. Bill and Betty were very loyal and committed Aquinas and St. Mary’s for many years. May she rest in peace.
