# PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear St Mary and Assumption Parishioners,

We have had our OCIA and Bible Studies kick off this past week. Fr. Beardslee and I are very happy that 17 people came to OCIA. If you would still like to come, please do. We offer babysitting and had a few children last week. Please let us know if you want babysitting. You can always learn more by attending this adult education. The classes are on Tuesdays from 6:30 – 8 p.m. in the Didier room.

The work on the North Tower continues. Please look at the insert or poster in the back of Church that explains what they are doing way up there. We need donations to help pay for this unforeseen expense. Contact me for more information.

I enjoyed having four priests from Bonacum come for dinner last week. Fr. Dunavan is very gracious in driving them up and back and even willingly does the grilling and food prep so I can enjoy patio time and drinks with them before dinner. They enjoy "getting out" and seeing the harvest, a slice of parish life and having us share our stories while they reminisce of their priestly lives. Hosting them is a blessing.

In the past month I had my annual physical in David City and the doctor recognized when listening to my heart that I have AFib (irregular heartbeats). It was a relief to find out because I have felt a bit lethargic and lightheaded when I did some intermittent running. I may have had it for a long time, but symptoms have gotten more noticeable. He gave me prescriptions for blood thinner and to lower my Blood Pressure. This week, I saw the cardiologist and now have a cardioversion (shock heart) scheduled for Friday and a PET scan for Monday (This is being written on Wednesday 9/10). I am hoping that all goes well but certainly appreciate your prayers. A parishioner who was a nurse suggested I take someone along to the cardiologist meeting, which I am glad that I did. They throw out a lot of vital information in a short period of time. I am learning more about the heart than I expected.

This week, I updated my will and estate plan. I have not done this in 25 years and been meaning to (I guess it is a benefit of having AFib). Originally, I had Aquinas (when I was Superintendent) and a few other charitable causes as my beneficiaries. Now, I will still give to Aquinas but I am giving 40% to St Mary's Parish Fund (with the Catholic Foundation of Southern NE). This fund earns what our St Mary's Endowment fund earns (CFSN), but the pastor can access it as needed. It has liquidity like a checking account. I think anyone my age (65) older, should have their will and estate plans in order. And, please remember St Mary's Parish in some fashion.
