Jason Campbell and his crew came with a heavy jack hammer on a skid loader and his crew and helped finished the job. Ray K and Ken S framed up the pads for the AC units and they are now poured, thanks again to Jason Campbell's concrete crew. The many loads of dirt were brought on sight by Paul Krivanek. Ron Lyons and Ken Smith helped bring the dirt close to the church with the cemetery tractor. Wednesday night, we had a very nice crew of 25 who helped to cut out the sod and put the dirt in place around the Church. We fed them burgers and brats afterwards (some of crew in picture). On Thursday, Fr. Schukei worked with another crew to bring in more dirt, reinstall the sod and further prepare the dirt for more sod and plantings. THANKS TO ALL WHO HAVE HELPED. We could not do it without you and we have saved a lot of money. We still have a ways to go but thank God we had a very successful week. We were blessed with a nice rainfall on Thursday as God's way of helping and approving our efforts.

Ordinations were Friday and Saturday at the Cathedral of the Risen Christ. We were very excited to have Ranil ordained a deacon along with Aguinas grad Augustine Reimers. Then Saturday, to have another Aquinas grad, Scott Nemec, ordained a priest along with Fr. Schilmoeller and Fr. Redinger.
