Pastor's Corner

Dear St. Mary/Assumption Parishioners,

We have had a beautiful week of weather. I am adding a Mass for rain because harvest is over, and we are still in a severe drought. I think most people would rather get the moisture in rain than in snow. Please God, bless our area with rainfall.

We had a good turnout at Harvest Festival with 1,027 in total served with 492 of those in carry out. Thanks to all who worked hard for the successful event. I thought the meal was delicious (and the four times I have enjoyed the leftovers). The tables seemed so much more full than last year, but far from the 1300 plus before Covid. The auctions profited \$27K which matched the previous high from last year. I am sure the committee will have a full-blown financial report before long. Thanks to all our donors and high bidders. It was a nice and successful day because so many came out for it.

While we are looking at numbers, our census during the two weeks of October showed we had 40% of St. Mary's people (on our records) in attendance and 60% of Assumption, Appleton in attendance. While both are above national average, as Pastor I am genuinely concerned about the 60% and 40% respectively who do not attend Church. The Bishop said at a recent meeting that across the Diocese we have between 40-45% of parishioners coming to Church with higher numbers in the rural parishes. Please join me in praying for those who have fallen away or are lapsed in the faith, that they will come back to Church.

I enjoyed going to the AKRS open house on Wednesday. What a huge, beautiful, high-tech space to serve the farmers and our community. While I was not exactly targeted as a customer, they were very welcoming, and the tour answered a lot of my questions. I learned about Track vs Tires, GPS and how they use the different sides of the service areas. I felt like Husker Harvest Days had come to town and it was fun to see so many of our parishioners there.

On Tuesday, we had our quarterly Priest Study Day at St. Gregory the Great Seminary. I always look forward to the furthering education and fraternity that we enjoy on these days. The talks were given by Fr. Daniel Cardo, who wrote The Art of Preaching. The Bishop had given us all the book, which I had read and really enjoyed. The study day on preaching was very worthwhile but not as complete as the book (like the difference between a good book and a movie). I felt it was a good shot in the arm and inspiration to improve my preaching. Please pray for me in that regard.


