Fr. Samuel Beardslee Bio

As I told people I was going to David City, everyone who knew anything or anyone about this place told me that it would be a good place to be. I'm looking forward to being the assistant here in what will undoubtedly be the smallest town I've lived in.

I was born in North Carolina, and traveled with my parents who were in the US Air Force. While I was in elementary school in Midwest City, Oklahoma, my parents divorced and I continued to live with my mother. I went to Forest Park High School in Woodbridge, Virginia, started college at Auburn University in Montgomery, Alabama, and then transferred to University of Mary Washington in Fredericksburg, VA. It was at UMW that I started to consider what God was calling me to, which led me to consider the seminary. Having lived in so many places, I felt called to enter with the diocese of Lincoln, due to my father and stepmother living in Peru, NE, as well as the other family members from both sides living in Lincoln, Norfolk, and other places nearby. After graduating from UMW with a bachelor's in English, I entered St. Gregory the Great Seminary for two years and continued to St. Charles Borromeo Seminary for four vears. I was ordained a deacon in 2016 and was assigned to St. Cecilia's in Hastings for the summer. I was ordained a priest May 27th, 2017, and celebrated my first Mass at St. Cecilia's before being assigned to Blessed Sacrament in Lincoln and as a teacher at Pius X high school. After two years, I was assigned to St. Patrick's in Lincoln in 2019. In 2021, I was assigned to St. Teresa's in Lincoln. Then in 2022, I was assigned as a co-chaplain of Pius X High School.

I enjoy games of many kinds; I'm happy to learn new ones, and happy to teach new ones as well. I also enjoy stories of many shapes and sizes, and teaching in general. I don't like limes or green skies, and my favorite color is sunset orange.
