Dear Parishioners,
Dear St. Mary’s and Appleton Parishioners, Thanks to all who came to our Parish Mission the past three days. I thought that Tim and Cheryl Prothman did an excellent job serving the dinners. Dan-ny Leger from Hope of the Poor is a very gifted and faithful Catholic musician who is so easy to work with. I am glad he had the projector for the lyrics so we could sing along and follow easily. I could listen and pray with him for hours. I thoroughly enjoyed each priest’s talk. Our prayer teams, mainly the Marian Sisters, were a huge blessing. I was glad that so many people took advantage of the chance to have others pray over them and help intercede on their behalf. The Bounce House, donated by Rick Comte, was ever popular with the children. Thanks also to our staff of Sr. Mary, Heather, and Fr. Tony Schukei for filling in wherever needed. God is so good, all the time.
