A Word on the Word: If you want to say the word, “word” in Latin, there are two choices. You can say “*scriptum*” or you can “*verbum*”. There is a very important distinction between the two words and the Church is very specific about the way she uses them in the text of the Mass. “*Scriptum*” means the written word, the text on the page. “*Verbum*” on the other hand, refers to the spoken word. The word said out loud has wings and can fly. While the word on the page is static. This is why when we say “The word of the Lord” we are referring to the spoken word.
