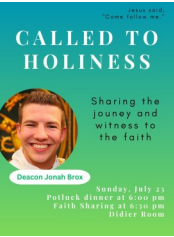

Pastor’s Corner

Dear St. Mary’s Parishioners,
Happy Butler County Fair Weekend. The Deacon and I enjoyed going to hear the Polka music, watching people dance and visiting in the beer garden. We plan to attend several more events this weekend.

We continue to thank Almighty God for the various rain events we have experienced in the past week and month. It is so important to thank and praise God for prayers answered. This endears us to Him and certainly helps the next time we come asking.

We ended up with a nice little group for our Henry Doorly Zoo field trip last Friday. Thanks to Fr. Schukei, Deacon Brox and the chaperones for making it happen. One child had cold feet before leaving but was most excited and talkative afterwards.

Fr. Schukei is currently Biking for Babies as his group rides from Rochester, MN to St. Louis Mo, where all the routes convene. He will traverse 600 miles in six days on behalf of the preborn, while sharing the Good News as they go with people they meet. Please pray he returns safe and sound on Tuesday.

We had our parish council and stewardship meetings this past week. I mention because these are very important, guiding meetings in my mind. I value the input of each person and our agenda helps to drive what I need to get done each week. Things are happening in many respects and being planned. For the meeting, I made a list of projects that we completed in the past year as a way of celebrating the good stewardship here at St. Mary’s. Next weekend we welcome a guest musician to play the organ/ piano named John Kane. He is from Humbolt, NE and works for Exodus 90 out of Lincoln.

On my day off, I went with two priest friends to “Sounds of Freedom” the new movie with actor Jim Caviezel, the lead actor (who played Jesus in the Passion of Christ). It’s based on the true story of Tim Ballard, the former Department of Homeland Security special agent who has devoted himself to fighting child sex trafficking, and who took his crusade private when he founded Operation Underground Railroad, with backing from Glenn Beck. The movie stars [Jim Caviezel](#), who in the 19 years since he played the title role of Mel Gibson’s “The Passion of the Christ” has been a go-to actor for the kind of faith-based projects the vast majority of Hollywood stars steer clear of. Wearing a trim dark beard and coppery blond hair, Caviezel plays Ballard. I strongly recommend the movie for education about this huge business. They say there are more people enslaved in the sex trafficking industry today than when slavery was legal.
