Dear Parishioners.

Happy St. Patrick's day! We celebrate Laetare Sunday and we "rejoice" in the nearness of Easter. We are over half way there and hopefully are starting to bear some fruit in our spiritual lives from our Lenten discipline and penance. The intensifying of Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving transforms our lives and makeS us more Christ like.

As pastor, I can say that our Wednesday night RCIA class is becoming very special and people's lives are changing. Real transformation in lives is occurring. I like the prayers of the scrutanies on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Sunday of Lent. These are minor exorcisms of the church that help cast out Satan and transform lives. The power of the priest's prayers is real and bring effect in what they say. This weekend the priest will pray "Free these elect from the false values that surround and bind them...stir up the desire for good in these elect...." We are hearing and seeing the growth of the power of the Holy Spirit in the lives of those in RCIA. It is like watching a fine-tuned team start to gel and come together at season end (think Jayhawk BB in March/ April 2022 ©). Keep praying for these RCIA members and their families.

We had a wonderful retreat last weekend with the three Disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ, who drove here from Texas. There will soon be a story with testimonies and a picture in the Southern Nebraska Register. I was surprised that for several it was their first retreat. Someone said, "it was so easy to register and attend, right here in our (newly refurbished) Didier Room". I am thrilled that we had a good number attend and that they were open to God's gift for them. We were all grateful for the good meals, serving and especially for the Sisters making the trek. I also am glad that Sr. Mary took on a lot of the organizing leg work. God is so good.

We had another productive monthly Parish Council meeting on Monday. I am grateful for our members (names in bulletin each week) and for their input. If you ever have something for the agenda you can mention it to one of them. Special thanks to Cheri Kobza for painting the hallow metal frames around all the (4) main doors in the church. They look so much better now. We received good news on Tuesday that the fabric for our cushion for kneelers has arrived at the State Pen and so work can continue. I am praying they come back before Easter.

On the financial side of things, I am happy to say that I have done some digging and research on the history of St Mary's Endowment and will get you a report before long. I took the info to Msgr. Herbek with my gratitude for his vision in beginning this essential part of our parish vitality.

On the debt side of things, we still owe Aquinas \$267,000 and we owed the Catholic Bishop of Lincoln \$180,000 as of the beginning of July, 2022. We have been paying \$10,000 per month (even though it was NOT budgeted) so now that our debt to the Bishop is down to \$100,000. I would welcome anyone who would like to donate to "Debt reduction". Additionally, while we should be in good shape on the budgeted expense side of things, we will be short in several budgeted revenue side of things, so please BE GENEROUS to the parish. Please look at how God has blessed you in the past years and what you have given back to God in your TITHE to St. Mary's. If it is way LOW, then start somewhere and trust that GOD will bless you in return. Put your faith in HIM and know "he, who sees all things, will repay you."
