

Pastor’s Corner

Praise God! We are off to a fantastic start with our Charity and Stewardship Appeal (CSA). With 130 pledges in, we have nearly \$35K pledged towards our goal of \$52K. For this first week, I think that is very good. Thanks to all who generously made a pledge. Thanks to those who worked tables in the gym, brought breakfast and provided hospitality. **We will again have the cards available in the gym for you to make a pledge.** On Sunday, we will also honor our seniors at the 10 a.m. Mass and have a little re-ception for them afterwards in the gym.

We had a nice turn out last week for our Called to Holiness. Mindy Schawang gave a powerful talk about her re-version to the Catholic Faith. I thought of her when reading these words in the Breviary: “You are strangers and aliens no longer. No, you are fel-low citizens of the saints and members of the household of God. You form a building which rises on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus Himself as the capstone. Through Him the whole structure is fitted together and takes shape as a ho-ly temple in the Lord; in Him you are being built into this temple, to become a dwelling place for God in the Spirit.” (Eph 2:19-20) I always find it inspiring when someone shares their faith journey. It is a sign that God is working in our lives, forming us as the Mysti-cal Body of Christ.

As you know, we are in the middle of a three-year Eucharistic Revival. On the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, Sunday, June 11, at 5 p.m, we will have a procession with Jesus in the monstrance around the blocks of our Church, St. Joseph’s Villa, Aquinas School and the Holy Family Early Learning Center. We will have four altars on the corners representing all corners of our parish and the world. We invite all parishioners to join us, especially the First Communicants in their handsome clothes. Afterwards, on the grass around the rectory and church, the Knights and PCCW will serve hamburgers, hotdogs, brats, spicy baked beans, chips, ice cream and brownies. We will have some outdoor games for those who are interested.

Parish book study: We purchased Brant Pitre’s book titled **Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist**. You can read it on your own, or we will offer a few study groups this summer. The book is an excellent historical background to what we celebrate in the Holy Mass. I learned a lot when reading it. The books will be here for our celebration of Corpus Christi.

May has always been the busiest month of the year for me, at least while in school work. While I have less on my plate, there are still graduations, ordinations, honor nights and lots of parties. I love that we honor the Blessed Virgin Mary throughout the month and enjoy her maternal care smiling down upon us.
