Pastor’s Corner

Dear St Mary’s parishioners,
Happy Easter! We had a beautiful Holy Week with lovely liturgies, attendance and lots of confessions, thanks be to God. The week began with the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral, and I was happy that several from Butler County were in attendance. The week culminated at the Easter Vigil with perfect weather for the celebration of Christ our Light to be held outdoors and everyone able to gather around the bonfire. We were blessed to have two adults Baptized and five more were received into the Church, Confirmed and received their First Holy Communion.

Thanks to Northside and Jeff and Bobbi Schmid for hosting our reception celebrations after the Vigil. I was glad we had a nice crowd to welcome the new Catholics. Masses on Easter are always very lovely too. Thanks to all who decorated for these liturgies and bought flowers in memory of family and friends.

I love the readings during the Octave and Easter Season. The post resurrection readings are so personal, human, and revelatory of the Risen Lord. Christ revealed himself at least a dozen times after His resurrection. He walked on the road with the two disciples to Emmaus, He fished with the fisherman and ate fish on the seashore, He instructed the seven on where to fish and they caught 153, He spoke to Mary of Magdalene when she thought He was the gardener, He came through locked doors to the upper room and revealed the wounds on his side, his hands and his feet, He spoke to Doubting Thomas, spoke to Peter about love and gave the great commission to the apostles. I am sure those who attend daily Mass, in their Magnificat or wherever would agree. Don’t miss out on these Sacred Scripture readings.

This weekend we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. This is a special time to think about the Mercy and love of Jesus as St.Faustina gave deeper insights to in her Diary. Please pray for our First Communicants and their 1p.m. Mass on Sunday. Then, we will pray the Chaplet in the Church at 3 p.m. Then, on Monday, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, at Assumption, we will have Mass at 6:30 p.m. for the intention of Rain. Our Parish Council meeting will follow immediately afterwards.

I had a nice quick trip on Easter to KCMO with family. I have two nephews getting married in the next month so that is very exciting, one in KC and one in NYC. The one in NYC is a very small wedding but I made the cut probably because I gave a kidney to him and we have always had a close connection. I pray that more family will follow soon. Three are still in HS and one in fourth grade so some are still young. Ten are of age and some are close to engagement. Some families are very good about falling in love and getting married. For other families vocations do not come so easily. I think it is important to pray for your vocation and ask God to direct your life and make it happen.

This weekend, there is a survey to pick up as part of the feasibility study for our campaign to pay off our \$350K debt and raise money for the endowment.
