### **Pastor's Corner**

Dear Parishioners,

The Sacred Triduum is the culmination of our Catholic Faith. Each day is central to the celebration of the Life, Death and Resurrection of Christ. The three days are linked together like the spans of the Francis Scott Key bridge that tragically collapsed. No day stands alone but rather each day is connected and gives meaning to the next and the Resurrection shines on every thing Christ did for us.

For forty days of Lent, we have journeyed together and offered more prayers, fasting and almsgiving. These prayers underlie our lives and celebrations: the Daily Masses, Rosaries, Stations and many other private prayers. I want to thank all who attended the Parish Mission and made it a powerful experience. I think many have enjoyed the Lenten Companion with Fr. Mark Toups. We cannot forget to thank God that we have parishioners fill the 24/7 Eucharistic Adoration in our Chapel.

After the celebration of the pivotal and climactic Holy Triduum we turn to the celebration of the fifty-day Season of Easter. Easter will be a more glorious Season as we celebrate Christ's victory over sin and death by His Rising to New Life. We begin with the Easter Vigil: the mother of all Vigils. We will celebrate the Lord's Resurrection and the new life given to those in the OCIA who receive their Baptisms, Reception into the Church, Confirmation and First Holy Communion. We welcome six parishioners with our friendship and offer them a variety of ways to be involved at St Mary's. I hope many come to Northside after the Vigil for our welcome celebration. Then OCIA turns to the Mystagogia stage wherein we continue to teach them how to be Catholics and nurture their budding faith lives.

We celebrate the Solemnity of the Octave of Easter and then Divine Mercy Sunday. On that Sunday, we have our First Holy Communion for the Second Graders in our parish. Then on Monday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation on April 8<sup>th</sup>. Confirmation will be April 21. May will include Ascension Thursday, Mother's Day and the conclusion of Easter on Pentecost. All of this before the ordinations at the end of May. Life goes fast, so take time to smell the lilies and gives thanks to God.
